

RESOLUTION NO. 3206

RESOLUTION DECLARING USED PIPE CLEANING MACHINE AND UTILITY BEDS AS SURPLUS, AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DISPOSITION, SALE AND/OR RECYCLING

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Department desires to surplus used one (1) Rockwell Pipe Cleaning Machine and two (2) Harbor 8-Foot Utility Beds; and


WHEREAS, in their present condition, such items have a *de minimis* value on an individual and/or cumulative basis, and the City no longer has any need for them; and

WHEREAS, Public Works desires to have the items declared to be surplus by the City Council consistent with its general powers under RCW 35.A.11.010 and other applicable law, and further desires to receive authorization to dispose of the items as Public Works management sees fit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists for the items to be surplus, and for granting Public Works management the approval to dispose of the items;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, that the City Council does hereby declare and authorize: (a) that the one (1) Rockwell Pipe Cleaning Machine and two (2) Harbor 8-Foot Utility Beds are surplus and have only a *de minimis* value; (b) that Public Works management may dispose of and sell such items without further approval or action by the City Council, each and all for whatever maximum prices can be obtained; and (c) that any net sale proceeds shall be deposited into the Water Fund No. 411 and Sewer Fund No. 415 in appropriate proportions.
