

RESOLUTION NO. 3217

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO PAY FOR EMERGENCY
REPLACEMENT OF STATION 21 HVAC SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Fire Department has been continually spending money to repair the heating and cooling system (a/k/a HVAC) at Station 21 for several years; and

WHEREAS, relatedly, management has been periodically contributing monies to the Fire Control Building Reserves (Fund No. 303) in anticipation of the expected necessity of replacing the system; and


WHEREAS, price quotations/bid for the potential replacement were sought and received by the Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Far West Climate Control's cumulative quote equates to \$70,027.54, which is an amount that is acceptable to City staff; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists to authorize the Fire Department to make this purchase;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the Fire Department be and is authorized to purchase the equipment and installation of an HVAC system replacement at Station 21 for \$70,027.54 (or a lesser amount, if that somehow proves possible).
