

RESOLUTION NO. 3222

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SIGNING AND SUBMISSION OF A WASHINGTON STATE PUBLIC WORKS BOARD FUNDING APPLICATION AND APPLICANT CERTIFICATION RELATED TO THE CITY'S BRADER HILL WATER STORAGE RESERVOIR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City desires – as what will be known as the City's Brader Hill Water Storage Reservoir Project (“Project”) – to construct a new one-million-gallon water storage reservoir at Brader Hill to enhance the water system's emergency storage capacity, and to also undertake related tasks and actions; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Public Works Board (PWB) has funds available with favorable interest rates; and

WHEREAS, the total Project cost is estimated to be \$2,850,000.00 according to HLA Engineering and Surveying, Inc., which serves as one of the City's contracted engineering consultants; and

WHEREAS, City staff desires to sign and submit a funding Application and an Applicant Certification to the PWB, and the City Council finds that good causes exist for such to occur;




