

RESOLUTION NO. 3239

RESOLUTION APPROVING PAYMENT TO SELAH ALLIANCE FOR EQUALITY (SAFE) FOR CREATION AND INSTALLATION OF MURAL

WHEREAS, the City is contractually obligated – via a seven-page Settlement Agreement that was entered into in mid-2022 – “to pay up to \$25,000.00 towards the mural” that the Selah Alliance for Equality (SAFE) group agreed to have designed and installed on a city-owned wall along North First Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the mural’s design and authorized its installation via Resolution No. 3141, dated August 13, 2024; and

WHEREAS, members and contractors of the SAFE group completed the installation of the mural in late-2024; and

WHEREAS, members of the SAFE group have now presented copies of invoices and receipts, to substantiate the total costs incurred to design and install the mural – and such total costs exceed the \$25,000.00 that the City is contractually obligated to pay; and


WHEREAS, City staff recommends that the City Council authorize the Finance Director to issue payment to the SAFE group for the contractually-obligated amount of \$25,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City Council found that good cause exists;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the Finance Director be and is authorized to issue payment to the SAFE group in the amount of \$25,000.00 via physical check or an electronic funds transfer.


