

RESOLUTION NO. 3257

RESOLUTION DECLARING METAL CHAIR RACKS AND METAL FOLDING CHAIRS AS SURPLUS PROPERTY, AND AUTHORIZING THEIR SALE OR DISPOSITION

WHEREAS, the City owns various equipment and furnishings used for operations and events, including at its Civic Center; and

WHEREAS, City staff has determined that two metal chair racks and 98 metal folding chairs are no longer needed for current or future use; and

WHEREAS, City staff believes such items should be declared to be surplus and then disposed of, in accordance with applicable policies and procedures governing the disposition of surplus items; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists for declaring these items to be surplus, and granting Civic Center staff the approval to sell and dispose of these items;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the City Council does hereby declare the above-specified items to be surplus, and also hereby authorize Civic Center staff to dispose of and sell such items without further approval or action by the City Council – with such sale(s) being made either to other area entities or to various other parties via a surplus website, each and all for whatever maximum prices can be obtained. Finally, any net proceeds shall be deposited into one of the City's specific funds for the Civic Center.
