

RESOLUTION NO. 3272

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A JOHN DEERE BACKHOE AND, ALSO, DECLARING AN EXISTING 1992 JOHN DEERE 310D BACKHOE AS SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING IT TO BE TRADED IN AS PART OF THE PURCHASE

WHEREAS, the City desires to replace its existing 1992 model year John Deere 310D Backhoe (Product Identification Number T031DB778429), because it is nearing its useful life, is used quite extensively by the Public Works Department, and is the only vehicle/piece of equipment that is capable of performing certain functions; and

WHEREAS, the cost of a replacement 410 P-Teir John Deere Backhoe is expected to be \$173,029.82 (inclusive of sales tax and trade-in credit), as set forth on a quotation that the City has received (which is labeled Quote Id 1298595); and

WHEREAS, to purchase the new backhoe the Public Works Department would utilize the Sourcewell purchasing cooperative, which is a governmental agency based in Minnesota that provides assistance to municipal entities throughout the United States; and the backhoe would most likely be purchased from Pape Machinery, which has a location in Yakima, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists to proceed with this transaction;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON, (a) that the 1992 John Deere 310D Backhoe (Product Identification Number T031DB778429) be and is declared to be surplus and is authorized to be traded-in as part of the purchase; and (b) that the Public Works Department be and is authorized to purchase and acquire a 410 P-Teir John Deere backhoe for a maximum price of \$173,029.82 (inclusive of cost) or any lesser amount that might prove possible; and (c) that the Public Works Director and/or his designee be and are authorized to sign any documents and to undertake any actions that are necessary to effectuate such purchase.
