

RESOLUTION NO. 3203

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAYOR AND CITY STAFF TO WITHDRAW THE CITY
FROM A PREVIOUSLY-ENTERED-INTO MISSING MIDDLE HOUSING GRANT

WHEREAS, the City Council – via Resolution No. 3064 – previously authorized the Mayor and City staff to enter into a Missing Middle Housing Grant (“Grant”) with the Washington State Department of Commerce, whereby the City could and would obtain reimbursement for a combined total amount of \$50,000.00 for certain tasks (a/k/a “deliverables”); and


WHEREAS, City staff completed the initial two deliverables and, then, sought and obtained \$25,000.00 under the Grant; and

WHEREAS, City staff has concluded that it would not be in the best interest of the City to proceed further with the Grant, and, instead, that the City should withdraw from the Grant without completing the final two deliverables; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that good cause exists to withdraw from the Grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELAH, WASHINGTON that the Mayor and/or City staff are authorized to withdraw from the Grant.
